He graduated from Fudan University for his BA (Law) and first MA (Economics), and from Lund University for his second MA (European Politics). Dr. Shu was visiting fellows and scholars at Harvard-Yenching Institute, LUISS Guido Carli, Catholic University Leuven, and University of Geneva.
