ASEAN Factors in the "Dual Structure" of Laos' Foreign Relations

发言概要： As a small country with weak national strength and strong neighbors, Laos has formed a "Dual Structure" in its foreign relations, relying on China and Thailand economically and Vietnam politically and militarily. In July 1997, Laos joined ASEAN and became a full member of ASEAN. ASEAN factors play the following roles in the "Dual Structure" of Laos' foreign relations. First of all, ASEAN multilateralism regional cooperation is an important pillar for ASEAN countries to pursue foreign policy of "Balancing among Great Powers". Laos cannot truly achieve "balance" on its own. Its efforts to actively integrate into ASEAN have enabled Laos not to be dominated by any party and increased its diplomatic space. Moreover, the establishment of the ASEAN economic community and China-ASEAN free trade area has facilitated the strengthening of economic and trade ties between Laos and China and Thailand. Last but not least, the concept of ASEAN's "Cooperative Security" and the construction of the political and security community guarantee the independence and sovereignty of Laos to the greatest extent, and guarantee the independence of Laos under the "Dual Structure", as well as weakening the security vulnerability brought by it.
