Topic: "Childcare: China's Experiences and its Remaining Problems"

With the development of China's urbanization process, the traditional family relations and neighborhood relations based on blood relationships and geographical relationships are almost disintegrated, and the family model has undergone significant changes, with the dual-worker nuclear family as the main form. Under this circumstance, the ability, effort, and risk bearing capacity of a family for childcaring is very limited. This requires the government to regulate the behavior of the government itself, the unit system, family, community, market, in order to provide better child care policy. This is extremely important for China's urban governance.
